Does this document contain all of the information from the template? Is it typed up, organized, <i>proofread</i> , and well designed (consistent headings, etc.)? (10 pts.)

Annotated Bibliography & Formal Outline Score Comments Total **40 pts.**

Does your Bibliography comprise of 5+ sources (2+ of which are scholarly) ? Are all of your citations consistently formatted according to MLA or APA standards? (10 pts.)		
Are your annotations 4-5 sentences long? Are they thoughtful, thorough and clear? Can I tell that you read/analyzed the material and assessed it thoughtfully? (10 pts.)		
Did you hand in a formal outline with your Research Portfolio? Does it present the organization of your paper clearly? Has it been proofread? (20 pts.)		

Research Paper Score Comments Total **100 pts.**

Does your paper present your topic in a clear and interesting way? Does it connect your subject to Purdue in some way? Do you take on a particular angle (showing the development of something; comparing one decade to another; telling the story of a person's contributions to a specific field)? (20 pts.)		
Does it tell the story using primary and secondary sources ? Are the sources chosen useful and relevant? Do they support the story the author is telling? Does you include topic sentences and then use source material to provide more specific details? (20 pts.)		
Did you use 6+ sources (4+ of which are scholarly) ? Is it clear that you did a considerable amount of research? Is there a depth to your research? Or is the research superficial? Is it clear that you learned how to navigate and utilize the library system and its website? (20 pts.)		
Are the sentences clear with good transitions ? (Do the sentences "flow" well?) Are there errors in word usage? Awkward phrasing or sentences? Strong use of signal phrases , lead-ins, and explanation of quotes and paraphrases ? (20 pts.)		
Are sources cited properly within the text (MLA/APA Style)? Is the paper formatted according to MLA/APA Style? (page numbers, margins, etc.) Is the Works Cited/Reference page properly formatted? Overall: title, format, professionalism (20 pts.)
