Psychedelic Research 3 semester credits, graduates take LDEP 590, undergraduates take 490. (LDEP -- Learning and Development, Educational Psychology)

Times and Hours: June 22 - July 9, Mondays -- Thursdays, 9 - 12:30.

Description: A survey and review of psychedelic research by reading the literature. Survey will be by reading and discussing <u>Psychedelic Drugs</u> <u>Reconsidered</u> by Lester Grinspoon and James B. Bakalar, both on the Faculty of Psychiatry at Harvard Medical School. This book surveys over 1,000 research articles, a dozen books, and 6 international symposia. Topics include the chemical structure and physicological effects of psychedelic drugs, historical and cultural uses, experiential reports, implications for treatment of psychological and physiological problems, implications for mind research, and directions for future research. The book is mecommend by Carl Sagan, among others.

The second required text will be one of three books by Stanislav Grof, M.D., Ph.D. The student will select one of the following:

> Realms of the Human Unconscious, an introduction to the uses of LSD with neurotic and psychotic populations, view of the human mind which comes from this work

The Human Encounter with Death, co-authored with Joan Halifax. Uses of LSD, DPT, and related drugs with terminal patients, mostly terminal cancer patients. Includes sections on parallel practices in various cultures and in historical times.

LSD Psychotherapy a book for counselors, therapists, and others interested in the professional implications of psychedelic therapy, a more detailed account of the practices and theory presented in <u>Realms</u>, apendices on research on chromosomal damage and on crisis intervention.

In addition to these required texts, graduate students will select a book from a list of approximately 20 books on reserve and report on it to the class. Undergraduates will select a short book or reserve article for a report. The lists will behanded out in class.

Recommended, but not required books available in the bookstore are:

Maslow, A. H. <u>Religions, Values, and Peak E<sub>x</sub>periences</u> Weil, A. <u>The Marriage of the Sun and Moon</u> Huxley, A. <u>Doors of Perception</u> Schultes, R. E. Golden Book of Hallucinogenic Plants

This is an intensive course requiring  $3\frac{1}{2}$  hours of class attendance each day and 4 - 6 hours of reading and homework each night. Students should be willing and prepared to commit themselves to this time and effort.
